1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. "On Monday 9th December 1974 a meeting of the Stoke Newington Branch of the Workers Revolutionary Party was held at Privacy

3. The main purpose of the meeting was to elect Branch Officers for 1975 and to ensure there was no further embarrassment to the WRP, which has recently undergone a number of traumatic internal splits, the attendance was kept to a minimum by Privacy, who was also responsible for the nomination of candidates.

4. After a 'pep-talk' by Privacy on the need for solidarity amongst members and the need for immediate disclosure to the Centre (WRP HQ. at Clapham) of any suspected members of the breakaway 'Hick/Jenkins' group, the following persons were elected as follows:-

- Privacy - Secretary
- Peter COLLINS - Chairman
- Privacy - Treasurer
- Privacy - 'Workers Press' Organiser
- Privacy - Young Socialist

5. The main changes are the replacement of Privacy as Secretary and Privacy as Chairman. This is seen principally as an attempt to bolster the industrial branches of the WRP which have been badly demoralised by the 'secession' of Privacy and Privacy to the Hick/Jenkins camp. Privacy is to resume full-time duties as party organiser at the Gestetner factory where he is employed and Privacy is to extend his 'cell' in the Overseas Telegraph Section of the Union of Post Office Workers."
