1. Submitted herewith are copies of four leaflets issued recently by the International Socialists:-

- a) Lorry Driver's Dispute - dated 4.11.74, this lists a number of firms which might have become concerned in the lorry drivers dispute. Branch members were instructed to visit local depots and transport cafes and to use recent 'Socialist Worker' articles on this issue as a basis for argument.
- b) 'Defend the Socialist Worker' - this urges financial contributions to meet the £5,000 costs awarded recently against Paul FOOT.
- c) & d) Deal with the jailing of the Shrewsbury pickets. They advocate IS activity at trade union level to agitate for the condemnation of the treatment of the pickets, strike action and a general campaign to secure the release from prison of the two pickets.

2. All four leaflets were issued by [Redacted] National Secretary, and b) was in conjunction with Paul FOOT, editor of the 'Socialist Worker'. None of the leaflets appear to be actionable.
