1. The following information has been received from a secret and reliable source:-

2. A meeting of the Freedom Collective was held on Thursday 21 November 1974, at the Freedom Bookshop, 81B Whitechapel High Street, E.1. The meeting commenced at 7 pm, ended at 9 pm, and was attended by nine persons.

3. Most of the meeting was taken up by Privacy giving a rambling address about a pro-American demonstration which he had organized in 1968 outside the American Embassy and the base at Midip. This speech was of no particular interest, except that on being interviewed by a provincial press reporter after the event, Privacy gave his name as Privacy.

4. With respect to Privacy's false name: Special Branch records show that Privacy is recorded as his alias.
