SUBJECT

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. Privacy, a party member who was arrested on the 'Right to Work March' from Port Talbot to Brighton in October of last year, has commenced work in the 'Right to Work Office' of the Socialist Workers Party Headquarters in Reading Lane E8. Although he will not be paid by the Party, therefore existing solely on unemployment benefit, he will assist Privacy and Privacy in collating the marchers and sponsors for the planned march from Newcastle-on-Tyne to London in May of this year.

3. Until Saturday 24th January, 1981, he was employed as a trainee bar manager by Young's Breweries Limited at the Privacy Privacy. He left after a disagreement following his refusal to sweep a path in the rear garden".
