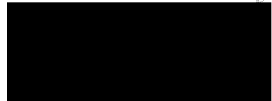

SUBJECT

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. Privacy a full-time worker in the Industrial Department at the Socialist Workers Party National Office, Reading Lane, E8, has recently taken up residence at Privacy where she may be contacted by telephone on Privacy

3. Privacy is currently a paramour of Privacy the Central Committee member with a specific responsibility for the 'Right to Work Campaign', thus it comes as no surprise that she is employed to deal predominantly with that area of industrial work. However, she receives no remuneration from the Party for her efforts and exists on £25 per week unemployment benefit in addition to any expenses granted by the 'Right to Work Campaign'.

4. It is known that at the end of April, after the annual Party Rally at Skegness, Privacy will leave her current post as full-time assistant to the National Secretary, Privacy. This will leave a vacancy for which Privacy is currently grooming Privacy. It is evident that Privacy has already made arrangements with Privacy to ensure that she obtains the post.
