1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

"On Wednesday 11th February, 1981 at Privacy Magistrates' Court, Privacy West Sussex, Privacy of Privacy Privacy was fined a total of £90 after being found guilty of a variety of motoring offences relating to his driving a hire van, during the perambulations of the '1980 Right to Work March' through the Sussex countryside.

3. In view of the fact that Privacy had been driving the vehicle at the behest of the march organisers, Privacy, the national Secretary of the 'Right to Work Campaign', authorised that these fines be paid from the official campaign funds."
