2. " [Privacy] , known as [Privacy] a member of the Socialist Workers Party who participated in the Right to Work Marches that were held in 1980, is currently working in the Industrial Department of the Socialist Workers Party National Office, Heading Lane, E8.

3. [Privacy] is currently unemployed and is living in the top floor flat at [Privacy].

4. On Friday 13th March 1981 he was arrested near his home address for the offence of 'insulting behaviour' resulting from his waving an 'SWP' banner and inciting members of the passing public to 'support the I.R.A.'.

Born circa 1960; height 5'7"; long, lank black hair; thin features; normally unshaven; scruffily dressed."
