The following information has been received from a secret and reliable source:-

"Participants in the "Bloody Sunday" demonstration which will take place in Leeds on Sunday 30th January 1963 have been asked to assemble at 1.30pm at Saville Park, Chapeltown, Leeds.

"Bloody Sunday" Demonstration 1963

The Troops Out Movement (TOM) has arranged for coaches to travel to the demonstration from Sheffield, Manchester, Birmingham and London. The London coach will depart from York Way, Kings Cross at 8am on Sunday 30th January 1963.

Reference to Papers 26/3/63

The other London coaches hired by Sinn Fein (SF) and the Revolutionary Communist Group (RCG) respectively will also convey demonstrators to Leeds. The SF coach will leave from the Hammersmith area and the RCG coach from somewhere in Britain. It is not known how many people are likely to travel on any of the London coaches.

Leeds TOM will hold a social at the Leeds Trades Club, Saville Mount, Leeds 7, from 8.30pm on Saturday 29th January 1963. Money raised at this event will be used to defray demonstration expenses.
