1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "A 'day school' entitled 'The Fight to Live' was held on Saturday, 18 December 1976 between 12 noon and 10.30 pm, at The Tabernacle, Fowis Square, W11, by the Federation of London Anarchist Groups (FLAG). Approximately fifty persons were present, most of whom were members of the Claimants Union.

3. Dave MORRIS, from the Anarchy Collective, made a short introductory speech, following which those present split into small groups to discuss such subjects as housing, claimants, the law and education. Eventually it was agreed that the only way to build a bigger campaign was to invite other organisations, including Big Place to join FLAG in discussions on the matter.

4. The meeting was followed by a social which consisted of a few scruffily dressed people sitting around listening to music, smoking and drinking."
