3. [Redacted] introduced the main speaker of the evening, Damon HALLAS, who spoke about the 'socialist alternative'. HALLAS started with a short history of the Labour Party in government and then launched into a long and very boring tirade on why he considered that the Labour Party had failed as a socialist government. HALLAS hardly touched upon the attitude that the Socialist Worker Party (IS) would adopt, as had been anticipated, with the result that about a dozen people walked out of the meeting. Following half an hour of questioning HALLAS also left the hall.
