



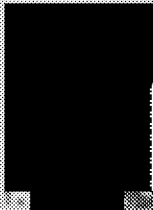

3. About an hour was spent in general discussion to decide the best course of action with regard to the CACTI demonstration. After much debate, Privacy suggested that a leaflet be produced and distributed locally. This was agreed by the others present. Privacy also stated that he would be willing to assist in the writing of the leaflet and it was finally decided that both he and Privacy would meet for this purpose on 19.3.77, at the home of Privacy.

4. The remainder of the evening was spent in discussion about the proposed libertarian bookshop on site. The two main issues raised were the objection to a socialist vegetarian, stated that she would try to secure a donation for the project from the Vegan Society and that she would be willing to do most of the cooking. Many people objected to the idea of having an entirely vegan cafe and of being dependent upon the Vegan Society and much discussion ensued (mainly from people wishing to know if they would be allowed to bring their own bottles of milk, etc). At the end of this debate, it emerged that Privacy would spend the next two weeks looking for suitable premises.
