Privacy

1. The following information has been received from a secret and reliable source:-

2. "Privacy" born "Privacy" has consistently avoided any association with extreme left-wing politics for the past three years. He claims to have secured a well-trusted job as a civil servant at the Treasury and is concerned that any active involvement with extremist organisations would possibly bar his future promotion should he be subjected to any vetting procedures.

3. "Privacy" now lives with his parent in the West Hampstead area and regularly finds his entertainment drinking in the Irish public houses in Kilburn High Road, London, NW6.

4. "Privacy's" long-standing friendship with Socialist Workers Party activist, "Privacy" came to an end during the period of industrial action taken by the Civil Service unions, early in 1979 when she discovered that he had crossed the union picket lines in order to gain entry to his office at the Treasury.

5. The photograph on file remains a good likeness of him although he has aged considerably since it was taken.
