1. The following information has been received from a secret and reliable source:-

2. "On Sunday 7th May 1983, **Privacy**, an active supporter of the Revolutionary Communist Party (RCP), was considered for membership by the Political Committee but was refused entrance into the Party.

3. As a result, **Privacy** has now ceased to work with the RCP, at least for the time-being, and has vacated his flat at **Privacy**.

4. Although **Privacy** was rejected other former members of the Revolutionary Gay Caucus (RGC) were approved and have apparently decided to stay within the RCP.

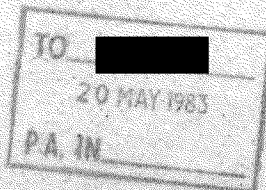
5. According to **Privacy**, the differences which **Privacy** had with the RCP had not been resolved. Although similar differences were experienced by other 'gay' candidates for membership, the Political Committee realised that **Privacy** was the only member of the former RGC with experience in left-wing politics and would be consequently less receptive to the combination of platitudes and bullying which the Party direct at younger comrades."
