SUBJECT

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "The Anarchist Centre, or 'offices' as they are known, at 107 Bank Church Lane, E1, is now completely re-wired and cleaned out and almost ready for occupation.

3. Structural defects however have been discovered which prevent the installation of the printing press. Accordingly, [redacted] is seeking alternative premises to house his printing equipment.

Anarchist Centre

4. In addition, a bitter dispute has broken out between the Zero and Anarchy Collectives, in that because of financial problems and also the lack of suitability of the premises for the printing press, the Zero people have decided to opt out of the scheme altogether. The Anarchy Collective, however, still wishes to use the building as 'offices' (ie meeting place et al). At present there is considerable tension between the groups, and it is doubtful if even the tact and good humour of [redacted] and Dave MORRIS will improve the situation."
