1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

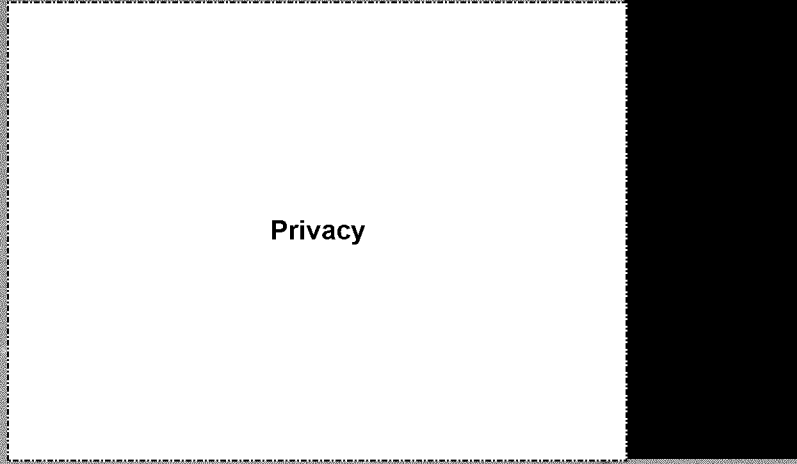
2. On Thursday, 18 May 1970, between 8 pm and 11.45 pm, at 29, Grosvenor Avenue, E5, the Anarchy Collective held its regular weekly meeting. Nine persons were present.

3. Most of the evening was spent in labelling and addressing copies of 'Anarchy'. However, there was some heated discussion about the dispute with the Zero Collective over office-sharing at 109, Back Church Lane, E1. It was mentioned that the Zero Collective was totally opposed to sharing a building with any group (and, in particular, with the Anarchy Collective) which was in the least 'anti-feminist' in its outlook."
