1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "A new organisation, composed largely of anarchists and libertarians, has recently been formed using the name 'British Anti-Nuclear Group (BANG)'. The location of its meeting place has not yet been ascertained, but it is known that one of its members is [Privacy] of the Anarchy Collective.

3. BANG has expressed strong desires to contact the organisation Greenpeace over the anti-nuclear question, with a view to launching some form of combined activity related to this issue."

4. There is no trace of the British Anti-Nuclear Group in Special Branch records.


5. [Privacy] is the subject of [Privacy]. The Anarchy Collective and Greenpeace are dealt with on 400/77/181 and 400/73/115 respectively.
