I wonder if you could discuss the following points with your source when you next meet:

1. Subsequent to the re-organisation of the London Branch at the Brixton Headquarters, do leading members of the RCP believe the changes to have been worthwhile. We would be grateful for one of your source's periodic numerical assessments of the strength of the various sub-branches in terms of members and contacts.
2. [REDACTED] reported on [REDACTED] that some building work is to be carried out at the London HQ [REDACTED]. We are interested in the nature of this work. [REDACTED] We appreciate that your source's access to this building is limited.
3. We should be most interested to learn if and when [REDACTED] is to move out of the [REDACTED]. When [REDACTED] moves out we should be most interested to know who moves in.
4. In December 1982 [REDACTED] a group [REDACTED] amalgamated with the RCP. Can your source say whether individual members of this organisation were automatically accepted into full membership of the RCP?
5. We are currently attempting to establish the weekly pattern of planning meetings at the London Headquarters. Any information that your source can give on this point would be most useful. There is particular interest in determining when the "London Diary" meeting is held. This is believed to be a joint meeting of PC members and the London Co-ordinating Committee.
6. There seems to be some current interest in establishing a new branch in [REDACTED]. We believe that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are to hold a series of public meetings in [REDACTED] during the week [REDACTED]. Any information on this point would be useful.
7. Is your source aware of any change in RCP policy in connection with defence cases?

I wonder if you could pass on my thanks to your source for his work on this unpleasant target.
