DG's Lunch with Sir David McNee - F6 Brief

1. The Ultra-Left subsection of F6 work in close liaison with the Special Demonstration Squad (SDS) of S Squad MPSB. To save work in F7 the identities/aliases of SDS operators are known to F6 and are recorded in [REDACTED]. Monthly targetting meetings are held with SDS, and their reports are channelled through F6 to consumer sections. In general, relations are cordial and the system works well.
2. The [REDACTED] subsection of F6 run one [REDACTED] agent jointly with E Squad MPSB. The agent is jointly funded, half by F6, half by MPSB and is jointly debriefed. The system works well and we are trying to extend it into other fields [REDACTED].
3. In one or two cases we have allocated [references] to the most regular E Squad informants and this information is channelled through F6. This has eased the task of customers in assessing the value of the intelligence provided by these informants. This was the case when these reports went direct to desks.
4. In general the liaison with E Squad is improving.
