

# Guys dolls... by Women's Liberation

A CALL for women to "refuse to be glamorised dolls for men's pleasure" was made today by the Women's Liberation Movement.

Women from all over Britain are uniting to "end domestic slavery" and are planning a mass march and demonstration in London to demand equal rights.

At a conference today to announce the demonstration, members detailed their four demands—equal pay for work of equal value and equal job opportunities; free contraception and abortion on demand; equal educational opportunities; and 24-hour nurseries.

## Rally

The militant women will march on March 8 from Speakers Corner to Trafalgar Square for a rally.

They also plan to hand a petition in at Downing Street outlining their demands.

Twenty thousand leaflets have been distributed in a bid to attract support and tell women in all walks of life how to fight for their rights.

Diane Langford, who is leading the campaign for equal education opportunities, said: "We want an end to domestic slavery.

"We refuse to be glamorised dolls for men's pleasure."
