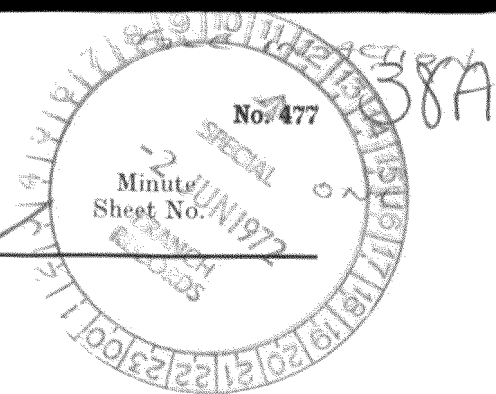

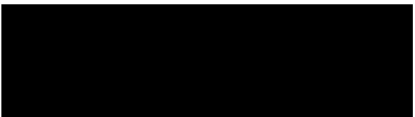

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "The Anti-Internment League plans to hold a march from Slough to Windsor on Saturday 24 June 1972. It is to be organised by the Slough branch of the A I L and it is expected it will receive the support of the majority of London A I L groups. Clann na h'Eireann have already promised to ask as many members as possible to attend. Apparently the route will pass at least three Army barracks.

3. The A I L is also organising a series of some 200 lectures 'to give the true facts' throughout the country by members of the Official and Provisional I R A from Derry and Belfast. These lectures are expected to take place in the latter part of June."
