Agreed 23/2/77.

1. The International Marxist Group and the Socialist Workers Party have each directed national support for a demonstration against racism and fascism to be held in the Stechford district of Birmingham on Saturday, 26th February. The purpose of the action, apart from propaganda, is to oppose the National Front which will be marching in the same area on that day.
2. At least one S.D.S. field officer will be obliged to take part in the left-wing demonstration (one or two more may come under pressure later in the week) and, bearing in mind the likelihood of conflict, I propose sending D.S. Walker to Birmingham on Saturday to look after our interests.
3. If you agree, I will make the necessary arrangements with West Midlands Police.
