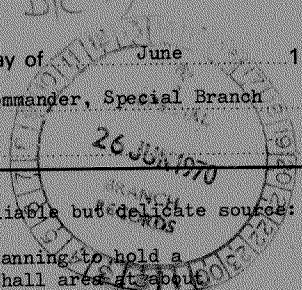

The following information has been received from a reliable but delicate source:

"Supporters of the Anti-Apartheid Movement are planning to hold a 'spontaneous action' in the Downing Street/Whitehall area at about 12 noon on Monday, 29 June 1970. It has been said that the 'action' will merely be the presentation of a petition at No. 10 urging the Government to abide by United Nations policy on the sale of arms to South Africa but there has also been talk, if sufficient support is forthcoming, of 'blocking traffic in Whitehall during the lunch period, ie from 1230 to 1430 hours'."
