I am in the vicinity of South Audley Street, ~~St.~~

Since about 4p.m. I have been with a group of some 200 anarchists from Liverpool and Glasgow who broke away from the main march at Hyde Park Corner. They have engaged in various sorts of hooliganism in the vicinity of Grosvenor Square.

They led the charge towards the U.S. Embassy along South Audley Street from its inception, and for the past two and a half hours they have been confronting police. They have been joined by contingents of the International Marxist Group and various V.S.C. elements from Hyde Park.

They are at present at the head of the column in South Audley Street which is confronting police at the junction of the S.W. corner of Grosvenor Square.

I will give a full account of their activities in due course.
