DC. HN331 and DC. HN68 were present at 'The Old Theatre', London School of Economics, until 1.10 am today. During that period a meeting of students was in progress and was attended by about 1,000 persons. The only definite information at present is that the students will assemble at the L.S.E. between 1 pm. and 1.30 pm. this afternoon and then march to Chancery Cross and the Embankment. The meeting was divided as to whether they should go to Grosvenor Square during the demonstration and Tariq ALI made a strong plea for that area being avoided. The mood of provincial students is that they do not want any violence to take place during the demonstration. The sleeping accommodation at the L.S.E. is packed to capacity and an appeal has been made for students living in London to spend the night at their own homes.
