1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:

2. A meeting was held by the Wandsworth Group of the Anarchist Workers Association on Thursday 4th March 1976 at the Peoples Aid and Action Centre, 8 Falcon Road, SW11. The meeting, which was attended by four persons, began at 8 pm and ended at 10.30 pm.

3. Privacy told those present that students at Westfield College, Kidderpore Avenue, NW3 intended to form an anarchist group. It was decided that the North London Group of the AWA should be informed of this.

4. The Campaign Against the Criminal Trespass Law demonstration on 28th February was then discussed. It was suggested that 90% of the persons on the march were squatters, who had been ignored by all left-wing political parties, and that the AWA should attempt to capitalise on this.

5. Following a brief debate it was agreed that the Group's name should be changed to 'South London Group' and that as from the beginning of April meetings would be held at Privacy's home address as it was warmer, more comfortable and there was always somebody there for the casual enquirer. It was announced that the Time Out magazine was renewing its 'Red Pages' column and that Privacy suggested the AWA should take advantage of this means of advertising itself.

6. The final item of interest was a request from Privacy that he be made a full member of the AWA. As no objections were raised he was automatically accepted."
