SUBJECT

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

"The London Workers Group has attracted several new followers during the past few months despite the fact that the group did not join the recently formed Direct Action Movement (a national anarcho-syndicalist organisation). Normally between fifteen and twenty people attend the weekly meetings, which are held on Monday evenings at the Metropolitan Public House, Farringdon Road, EC1. However, as from the 10th October, 1979, the group will meet on Tuesday evenings at the same venue.

2. During the last few weeks the LMG has been preoccupied with organising a memorial to the American Joe HILL, a founder member of the Industrial Workers of the World (IWW).

3. The LMG has recently elected Jeremy GUILD as Secretary and Tony WILLIAMS as Treasurer of their organisation, posts formerly held by Adam FLOWERS and Penny WHITE respectively.

4. At their meeting held on 1.10.79 members were informed that the Group's total assets amounted to £60 and it was decided to donate £10 of this sum to Persons Unknown.

5. The next public meeting of the group will be held on 4th November, 1979, at the Metropolitan Public House, the subject: 'Redundancy or Occupation'."
