Information has been received from a delicate but reliable source that members of the Britain Vietnam Solidarity Front will go to Tower Hill on Thursday, 1st May, 1969, to take part in one of the anti-Trade Union Legislation demonstrations (not specified).

It had been reported that in consequence of a cable from the United States of America, the B.V.S.F. might organise some form of spontaneous demonstration at the U.S. Embassy, Grosvenor Square, W.1, on May 1st in support of an American negro convicted of murdering a policeman in California, who was appealing against sentence and making an application for bail on that day. In view of the foregoing information, it now seems highly improbable that there will be any form of demonstration in Grosvenor Square on 1.5.69.
