1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-
2. "On Thursday, 5 December 1974, the Twickenham Branch of the International Socialists held a closed meeting at [Privacy], Twickenham, the home of [Privacy]. The meeting, which lasted from 8.10 pm to 10.15 pm, was attended by 10 persons.
3. The entire meeting was taken up with the stance to be taken by the IS in connection with the recent bombing campaign in England. After a lengthy discussion the conclusion was reached that although the organisation could still support the IRA in their fight against the Troops and the Protestants, it could under no circumstances support the indiscriminate bombing of workers in either England or Northern Ireland."
