1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. Privacy an associate of Freedom Collective and former member of West London Anarchists, lives at Privacy near Privacy employed as an ancillary worker at Privacy Hospital, Privacy and claims to be secretary of the hospital's branch of the National Union of Public Employees (NUPE).

3. Aged about 43 years, Privacy is mentally unstable and has suffered several nervous breakdowns; for some years he has been a voluntary patient at the psychiatric unit of Privacy.

4. Conversation with the subject is an exhausting affair; not only does he appear incapable of pursuing one coherent argument, but his speech is punctuated with sudden unconnected outbursts, generally concerned with his conviction that police regularly search his room and intercept his mail. He claims to be known to Notting Hill Police as 'the local nutter'.

5. Privacy shows no interest in developing anarchist contacts and it is difficult to determine why he maintains his link with Freedom; indeed, his disruptive presence at busy despatch nights on alternate Thursdays is tolerated only grudgingly. It was decided long ago that he would never be invited to join the editorial collective and he only writes the occasional film review which is invariably rejected.

6. The subject claims to have an aunt in East Berlin whom he would like to join should he ever be discharged from his employment with an ill health pension."
