1. The following information has been received from a secret and reliable source:-

2. "Cornelius CASHW, a leading activist in the Revolutionary Communist Party of Britain (Marxist-Leninist) until his recent death in a road accident, was buried on Tuesday, 22nd December 1951, at Manor Park Cemetery, Sebert Road, E.7. Approximately 200 persons attended.

3. Chris COLMAN led the short secular ceremony which, apart from family contributions, featured tributes from [redacted] and [redacted]. There was a short programme of songs from the Progressive Cultural Association (PCA). After the funeral a reception was held at Manor Park Library, Romford Road, E.12.

4. Inevitably, the Party used the occasion to stimulate further revolutionary consciousness and it was made quite clear that there would be no shortage of people eager to carry on and develop his work."
