1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "The London Greenpeace Group are to continue their series of pickets and leafletting outside Australia House, WC2 and Tilbury Docks. However, delays in the arrival of the container ships, mv 'Act One'/mv 'Kangourou', present a continual problem for the organisers. The revised schedules at present are as follows:-

mv 'Act One': Due at Tilbury on 22 October 1977 and at Merseyside on 28 October 1977.

mv 'Kangourou': Due at Tilbury either 24/25 October 1977.

3. Pickets are arranged as follows:-

Saturday 22 October 1977: Picket Australia House, Aldwych, WC2 12 noon - 2pm

Picket/leafletting at Tilbury Docks and Town 6.30a

Picket Tilbury Docks 1pm.

4. Until a firm date for the arrival of the mv 'Kangourou' is established, no action regarding its movements has been planned. At this stage it is not anticipated that pickets in Merseyside for the docking of mv 'Act One' on 28 October 1977 will be supplemented by members from London. However the London organisers are sending all information available to sympathetic groups in the Merseyside area."
