Insofar as "source planning" in its generic sense is concerned, I have spoken to Commander Rollo Watts and agreed that individual squad Chief Superintendents should have discussions with appropriate officers from your Service. They would survey their respective scenes in greater depth and come up with suitable recommendations in regard mainly to priority of individual and organisational targets; identification and / exploitation of short and long-term sources;
