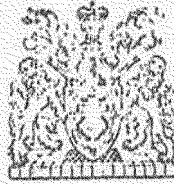

PUBLIC ORDER EVENTS ON SATURDAY 28TH APRIL 1979

1. Introduction

- (a) At 11.00a.m. it is anticipated that Mr. John TYNDALL, Parliamentary Candidate for Hackney South and Chairman of the National Front, will hold an open-air meeting in the East End of London.
- (b) From 10.30a.m. members of 'The Society for the Protection of the Unborn Children' will begin assembling at Reformers Tree, Hyde Park, W1, where at 12.00 noon a meeting will be held in protest against the law relating to Abortion. At 2.30p.m. those assembled, who are expected to number between 25,000 and 50,000, will march to Temple Place, WC2 by the following route:-

Cumberland Gate (against traffic)	Haymarket
Park Lane (Southbound)	Pall Mall East
Piccadilly	Trafalgar Square (North and East sides)
Piccadilly Circus	Northumberland Avenue
Coventry Street	Victoria Embankment
	Temple Place

- (c) At 2.00p.m. 'Socialist Unity' are holding a meeting at the Dominion Car Park, Southall, to protest against police action in Southall during a demonstration on Monday 23rd April, 1979.

It is also likely that a march will take place in Southall at some time during the day.

Communications

'X'-Ray Control situated at Southall Police Station will be open from 7.30 a.m. in connection with this event and will operate on Channels 6 and 65.

R/T Vans

An R/T van call-sign 'Tango' will report to 'Hunter 50' at Featherstone Road, Southall at 1.00 p.m.

A second R/T van call-sign 'Sierra' will report to Southall Police Station at 11.00 a.m. and remain on reserve as directed by 'X-Ray' Control.

Charge Centre and Prisoners

A central charge centre located at Sunbury Cadet School, Green Lane, Sunbury will be open for this event from 10.30 a.m. and all prisoners will be dealt with at this centre unless otherwise directed by 'X-Ray Control'.

'X-Ray Control' is to be contacted before prisoners are conveyed to the charge centre.

Holding Centre

There will be a holding centre at Dormers Wells Senior School, Dormers Wells Lane Southall, near the junction with North Road/Allenby Road. It is anticipated that as police become disengaged from the operation that they will be held on reserve at this location.

Dismissal

Police will be dismissed by Deputy Assistant Commissioner 'A' (Operations).
