- 2. The above premises have been divided into two sectors comprising (1) D.M. Sub-Division less the area surrounding Dow Chemical Co. Ltd., and (2) D.P. and D.R. Sub-Divisions plus the area surrounding Dow Chemical Co. Ltd. Each sector will be under command of a Superintendent with Chief Inspectors assisting at specific places as shown below:-

- 3. A charge centre will be in operation at Paddington Police Station under command of a Chief Inspector vide Operation Order No. 900, on 26th and 27th October. Ordinary charges not connected with Public Order will be taken at the station in whose area the arrest was made except those occurring in the Paddington Sub-Division area will be taken at D.R. Prisoners charged at the Charge Centre will be bailed to appear at Marylebone Magistrates Court.
- 4. On each day a Superintendent will act as late duty officer until midnight.
- 5. Details of allocation of Senior Officers and deployment of manpower on 26th and 27th October are respectively set out at Appendices A and B.
- 6. Details of C.I.D. duties are set out at Appendix E.
- 7. Members of the Special Constabulary will provide general coverage of beats on the Division from 2 p.m. to 10 p.m. on Sunday, 27th October 1968. They will operate a team policing system, using the D.P. van which should be made available for their use from 2 p m. at D.D. The M.S.C. will be under the central command of Commandant Ritchie who will be based at D.D. where he should be contacted for assistance in routine policing matters on the Division.
- 8. In the event of difficulty with R/T communication or non availability of sets, personal radio communication will be used. The D.M. channel will be used by Sector 1 and the D.P. channel by Sector 2. Briefing 4 p.m. Friday, S.Q.6. More detailed instructions regarding communications and transport will be issued as soon as the information is available.
 - 9. Superintendents will arrange relief for refreshment where appropriate.
 - 10. Superintendents will lay down the limits of early and late short patrols outside the periods of peak coverage of target points.
