OPERATION ORDER No. 37/74.

MARCHES AND MEETINGS - Saturday, 15th June, 1974.

1. Introduction

(a) At 2.00 p.m. approximately 1,500 supporters of 'Liberation' will assemble at Victoria Embankment, WC2, to protest against the policies of the National Front. At 3.00 p.m. those assembled will march to Red Lion Square, WC1 where a meeting will be held in the Conway Hall.

The route of the march will be:-

Temple Place Arundel Street Strand Aldwych Kingsway High Holborn (against traffic) Red Lion Street Theobalds Road Old North Street Red Lion Square

(b) At 2.30 p.m. approximately 1,000 members of the National Front will assemble at Tothill Street, SW1, in protest against the Governments Immigration Policy. At 2.45 p.m. those assembled will march to Red Lion Square, WC1 where a meeting will be held in the Conway Hall.A petition will be handed into No. 10 Downing Street en route.
