1. Introduction

7. Detail of Duties

The detail of duties for the Uniform Department is set out in Appendix 'A', for Traffic Department in Appendix 'B', and Commander 'P' Division will arrange duties for the Criminal Investigation Department Officers employed on these events.

8. Dress

Commanders, No. 2 (dismounted); Chief Superintendents to Constables, No. 2 with raincoats; Mounted men as directed by Chief Superintendent A.5 Branch; Traffic Branch as directed by Commander B.8.

9. Transport

Coach transport will be provided to convey all officers on serials 301 to 334, 339 to 382 and 411 to 418, to and from their places of duty in accordance with Gen. Memo. 25/69.

Commanders concerned will arrange for the time and place at which the coaches are required to report to be forwarded to Transport Branch (B11) by telephone, extension [redacted] as soon as possible.

10. Communications

(a) Operations Room at New Scotland Yard (Call-sign 'GT') will be opened at 9.00 a.m. and Channels 8 and 65 will be used for this operation together with Channel 12 for use by 'B' Department.

(c) Personal Radios - Channel 65

Personal radios will be issued to all officers of the rank of Inspector and above and Sergeants on Serials 394, 395, 397, 398, 400, 401, 403, 404, 406, 407, 409 and 410 and will be collected at the time and place of parade, as shown in paragraph 3.

At the conclusion of this event all officers issued with radios are to ensure that the radios and completed A.8 Proformae are returned to the place of issue or to the R/T Control Van.

(d) Channel 8

CHANNEL 8 IS TO BE USED FOR ALL NON-URGENT MESSAGES e.g. ARRIVAL AT PLACE OF DEPLOYMENT.

(e) Call-signs

Call-signs used will be in accordance with the instructions contained in Appendix 'E' of the M.P. Telecommunications Manual.

N.B. OPERATORS ON R/T COACHES ARE TO REPORT ON DUTY BY R/T TO OPERATIONS ROOM, WITHOUT FAIL, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER PARADING ON DIVISION AND INSPECTORS I/C SERIALS ARE TO ENSURE THAT A LISTENING WATCH IS MAINTAINED ON THEIR UNITS AT ALL TIMES.

10. Communications - Continued.

(f) Traffic Division Officers

TRAFFIC PATROL OFFICERS SHOULD ENSURE THAT ALL HANDSETS ARE REPLACED CORRECTLY AFTER TRANSMISSION TO OBVIATE UNNECESSARY INTERFERENCE WITH GENERAL R/T TRAFFIC.

(g) R/T Engineer

An R/T Engineer will be available to deal with R/T breakdowns and can be contacted through 'GT'.

(h) Transhailers

Transhailers will be available, if required, on the R/T Control Van.

11. Deployment

Serials are only to be redeployed on the directions of the Senior Officer on duty and with the knowledge of Operations Room.

Redeployed serials are, without fail, to report their arrival at their new location to Operations Room by the use of Channel 8 (Channel 65 will only be used if a serial is redeployed on foot).

12. Conduct of Police

All officers are to be instructed that they must report any incidents or complaints etc., in which they become involved or of which they become aware, to a supervising officer.

Chief Superintendent D. Patterson (ZN) will be employed as Complaints Officer from 10.00 a.m. at Lewisham Police Station, and all complaints should be referred to him.

13. Charge Centres and Prisoners

(a) Charge Centres will be set up at Lewisham, Deptford and Catford Police Stations.

(b) In the event of arrests, Operations Room MUST be contacted for allocation of Courts at which prisoners are to appear.

(c) National Front prisoners will be taken to Deptford Police Station, and Socialist Worker Party prisoners to Lewisham and Catford Police Stations. Prisoners must also be segregated in coaches.

14. Leave

Attention is drawn to the telprinter message sent at 11.20 on 3rd August, 1977.

Forms A.8/10

Divisional Commanders are to ensure all officers i/c serials are issued with Forms A.8/10. The attention of all Sector Commanders and Officers i/c serials is drawn to the need to fully complete ALL headings in the form. It is necessary to show all places and times at which the serial is deployed throughout the course of the operation. Officers i/c serials are to sign the A.8/10 when it is completed and hand it to the Sector Commander who will check and counter-sign it and ensure that it is handed in at the conclusion of the event.

4. Special Instructions:
 - (i) Diversions: The information given in the introduction to the Operation Order has been obtained from a variety of sources and may be subject to alteration without notice. In the event of the marches proceeding according to plan, any pre-planned diversions shown in paragraph 8 may be implemented.
 - (ii) L.T.E buses: Bus controllers will be on duty in the operational area to deal with buses affected by this operation. Mobile R/T bus controllers will also be on duty and every assistance should be given to them. As far as possible buses will be held at convenient points on route and will not be diverted. Bus controllers have been instructed to co-operate closely with Police at all times. Urgent messages affecting bus operation will be passed through Traffic Controller at C.O., who will inform Central Bus Controller and Operations Room.
5. Role of Traffic Division:
 - (i) ALL TRAFFIC DIVISION PERSONNEL ARE TO REMEMBER THAT THEY ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC AND FOR REPORTING INCIDENTS.
THEY SHOULD REMAIN CLEAR OF DEMONSTRATORS AT ALL TIMES - UNLESS SPECIFICALLY DIRECTED TO DO OTHERWISE BY THE TRAFFIC CONTROLLER (see paragraph 5 (ii)).
 - (ii) Removal vehicles: The removal vehicles may be required to be used for the removal of barriers and landrovers should be equipped with tow ropes, chains, weaver jacks, the specially issued fire extinguishers and bolt cutters.
6. (i) Reports:

Forms for reporting all incidents involving Traffic Division personnel during the operation will be completed and submitted by Sergeants and above when they report in person to the Traffic Controller at the end of the tour of duty.

 - (ii) Commander B.8 will submit a report on the working of the traffic arrangements as soon as possible after the demonstration for the information of the A.C 'B'.

Diversions

Except when the marchers have entered Algernon Road, it is hoped that traffic will be kept running alongside demonstrators at all times, but if roads are closed to general traffic by demonstrators, or when a senior officer decides to close a road to general traffic, the following diversions may be used :-

Code

NORTHBOUND traffic towards the operational area can be diverted either :-

via Catford Road, Beechfield Road, Standstead Road, Brockley Rise, etc. 'A'

or

via Rushey Green, Brownhill Road, St Mildreds Road, Eurntash Road, etc. 'B'

or

via Ladywell Road, Adelaide Avenue, Brockley Road, etc. 'C'

or

via Lewisham High Street, Lee Bridge, Belmont Hill, Lee Terrace, etc. 'D'

SOUTHBOUND towards the operational area can be diverted :-

via Old Kent Road, Ilderton Road, Rotherhithe New Road, Evelyn Street, Creek Road, etc. 'E'

EASTBOUND towards the operational area can be diverted :-

Queens Road, Pomeroy Street, Old Kent Road, Ilderton Road, as then as for southbound. 'F'

WESTBOUND towards the operational area can be diverted :-

via Burnt Ash Road, St Mildreds Road, Brownhill Road, Rushey Green, Catford Road, etc. 'G'
