Catering Arrangements

Communications

A Control room call-sign 'X-Ray' will be in operation at Southall Police Station.

Personal radios will be issued at Southall Police Station.

At the conclusion of the event, all officers issued with radios must ensure that they together with completed A8 proformae, are returned to the 'X-Ray' control.

Conduct of Police

All officers are to be instructed to report any incidents or complaints in which they become involved or of which they become aware, to a supervising officer.

Forms 3166

District Commanders will ensure that all officers i/c Serials are issued with Form 3166, which must be fully completed and handed in at the conclusion of the event.

Leave

Officers may be required to work on their rest days at the discretion of Commanders in accordance with GO Section 6 para 71.
