Reference to Papers

1. The following information has been received from a reliable source:-

2. "On Sunday, 19th November 1978, at 8pm, at the Methodist Church Hall, Queen Road, NW6, the Neopheat and West Hampstead Central Against Racism/Anti-Social League Group held a general meeting, attended by about twenty persons.

3. Proceedings began with a report by Neil HARDIE, secretary, on the previous meeting of the organising committee. Paul O'FLY, acting as chairman for the evening, then discussed the 'Nights against the Nazis' meeting, which had been held at Brent Trades and Labour Hall three days earlier.

4. After this, there was a talk from **Privacy** about her organisation, Campaign Against Immigration Law (CAIL). In the conclusion of her speech, it was decided to affiliate to CAIL.

5. Nominations for vacant places on the Group's organising committee were then made, with the results as under:-

- a) Unpaid-up membership secretaries - Bob O'FLY and **Privacy**.
- b) Delegates to AIL National Council - Neil HARDIE.
- c) Delegates to Central Against Racism Central - **Privacy**.

6. **Privacy**, Treasurer, revealed that the Group had about £100 in its account and that this sum was likely to be increased shortly.

7. Afterwards, a discussion on 'Which way for the AIL', led by **Privacy** of the AIL Central Council, aroused a long and heated debate.

8. Finally, some forthcoming activities were announced, including:-

- a) A public meeting arranged by Burnt Oak AMI for 6.12.78 at 7pm.
- b) A Gurners Stock House 'Day of Action' on 8.12.78.
- c) A meeting on 'Immigration, Race and Nationality', organised by the Baldwin Society for 11.12.78, at 7pm, in Room 8.075 at the London School of Economics.
