Notes for attendees



ARRIVAL AND ENTRY

- Typically, the morning sessions start at 10 AM, and the afternoon sessions start at 2 PM. Please check the Inquiry website for the latest timings.
- Please arrive at least 30 minutes before the start of the session. If you do not arrive in advance we may need to give your space to someone on the waitlist.
- Registration does not guarantee entry. If demand exceeds availability for any given day, it may not be possible for all who register to attend in person. Anyone affected will be informed at least one week before the hearing date



SAFETY AND SECURITY

- You will need to sign in at the registration desk when you first arrive. The registration desk is located at the Reception area of the International Dispute Resolution Centre located on St Paul's Churchyard. To locate the the entrance on Google Maps, please search for Juxon House.
- Please bring a form of Photographic ID (such as passport, driving licence) as this will be required to check in on the day.
- If evidence is to be heard in private, public attendees will be asked to leave the gallery.
- Hot drinks & food are not permitted in the hearing room.



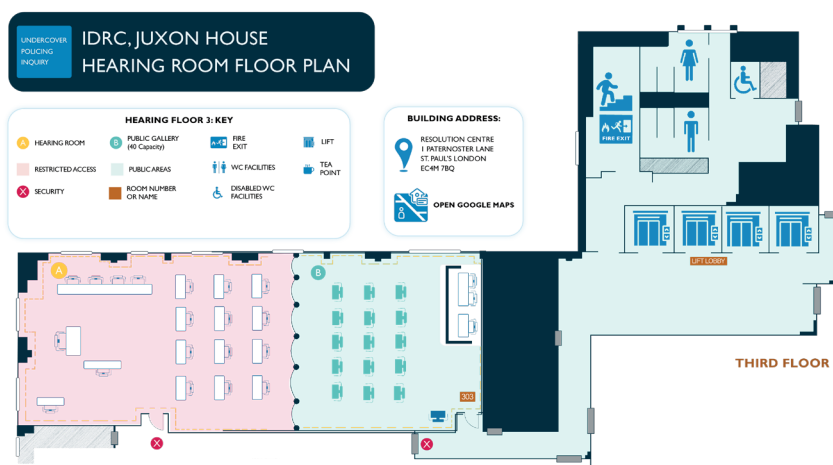
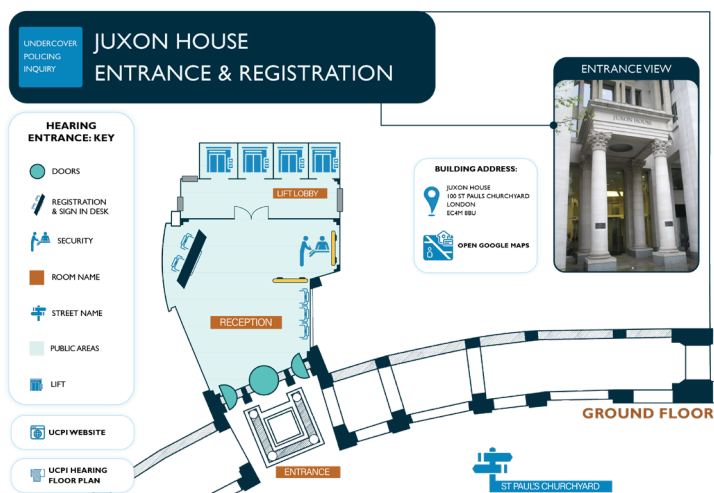
DEVICES & COMMUNICATION

- Following each open hearing, the Inquiry will publish the day's transcript on the Inquiry website, along with any evidence referred to on the day.
